It was not uncommon for the business to run 24 hours a day, dividing shift work up among the employees, in order to meet last minute deadlines and emergency orders placed by customers.

Their list of clients included major Atlanta Area "Trash & Trinket" advertising agencies which contracted to do their embroidery, along with such companies as Ford, Pepsi, AT&T, DeVilbiss, Sikkens, and many more. Some of their more recognizable customers included creating an embroidered velvet CD pouch for the rock band Collective Soul's award winning song.

Exquisite also catered to the small to medium size business which were springing up all over the Atlanta area during the early 1990's.

Due to their heavy involvement in NASCAR Stock Car racing, they made crew uniforms for teams such as Hendrick Motorsports, Buckshot Racing, Tammy Joe, and John Runyan.

In 1995, the business expanded to the Detroit Michigan area where it continued to grow. The bulk of the business consisted of supplying embroidery services to such companies as Ford, GM, Chrysler, Toyota, Morgan Services, Akebono, SABO, and more.

In 2007, the management decided to move the business to Springfield, Missouri, mainly to get out of the long cold winters. The move has been good not only for business, but for the sanity of the employees due to the slower pace of the south and the many recreational activities the area provides.
